Primary statewide efforts will be concentrated to achieve progress in the following areas:

Goal I: A coordinated approach among public and private cancer control stakeholders to implement cancer activities statewide

Develop System Capacity

- Continue development of an integrated statewide cancer council network including the Cancer Control and Research Advisory Council, the Florida Cancer Plan Council, and the regional cancer collaboratives
- Support the Florida Cancer Data System to capture diagnosis and treatment information from hospitalized and non-hospitalized cancer patients

Goal II: Floridians practice the healthy behaviors associated with prevention of cancer or to reduce risk

Prevention

- Strengthen links with partner organizations to reduce the burden of tobacco and obesity
- Emphasize the danger of UV ray exposure in Florida especially in youth
- Promote the adoption of Human Papilloma Virus vaccine for Florida's youth

Goal III: Floridians have access to appropriate health information and effective health services for the timely detection, diagnosis, and treatment of cancer

Treatment and Access to Care

- Improve access to care for minority populations through the utilization of Community Health Workers and Cancer Navigators
- Promote measures to increase cancer screening and early detection

Goal IV: Floridians affected by cancer are aware of and have access to quality, appropriate services for quality of life, palliative care, and survivorship

Survivorship

- Improve record keeping systems and raise awareness of resources for cancer survivors
- Promote the provision of treatment summaries and follow-up care plans
